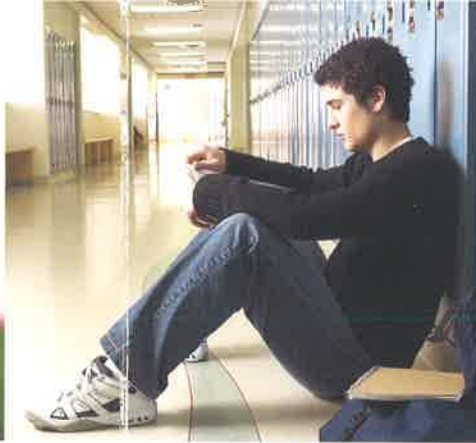

For adolescents ages 13-18 with a psychiatric, substance abuse, or co-occurring mental health problem that significantly interferes with functioning at school, at home, or with peers.

- Psychiatric treatment
- Substance abuse treatment
- Co-occurring disorders

PARTIAL HOSPITAL PROGRAM

- For teens who are unable to manage in school
- 9:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., five days per week

INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM (AFTER SCHOOL)

- For teens attending school but in need of intensive treatment
- 3:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m., three days per week*



Supporting Adolescent Girls Emotionally (SAGE) (ages 13-18)

OUTPATIENT
PRINCETON

SAGE offers a supportive and safe environment to explore developmental issues unique to teenage girls as they transition into young adulthood.

- Helps girls identify and understand their emotional struggles and impulsive behaviors
- Assists girls in building confidence and developing positive coping skills
- Comprehensive dialectical behavior therapy (DBT) for girls who struggle with suicide ideation, self-injury, and impulsive behaviors
- Specialized groups for girls with a history of trauma and/or difficulty with emotion regulation
