**HOLY WEEK**

**PALM SUNDAY** We wave our palms as we sing in procession. Once we are seated, the palms slip and slide and stick out all over. The palms we use to remember Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem and his place of honor in our life are admittedly awkward. They don't fit easily. But then, neither did Jesus in the holy city; neither can the holy be conveniently tucked away out of sight, in our lives. And so our fumbling with the conspicuous palm branches may be an especially appropriate way to begin Holy Week.

### **CHRIST BIDS YOU WELCOME TO THE TABLE!**

*ALL who seek the living God are invited to commune and share in the forgiveness and strength of God. Rejoice that the living God has invited you to share in this feast that you might find newness of life in Christ. We provide options in receiving the wine: common cup at the altar, individual cups filled at the altar, pre-filled cups of grape juice or water brought by you from the tray on your way to the altar. The ushers lead us to the table where we kneel (if we are able) to receive the bread. Then we drink once a liturgical assistant says to us, "the Blood of Christ Shed for You." Those unable to partake of wheaten bread, GLUTEN FREE COMMUNION WAFERS are now being offered. You will find small blue cubes by each of the filled wine trays. Take a cube with you to the altar and place it on the altar rail as a signal to the one distributing the bread that you wish to receive Gluten Free Bread. We then return to our pew for prayer. Children also are invited forward to receive communion or blessing at your preference. Children receiving a blessing only should cross their arms across their chest.*

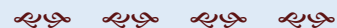

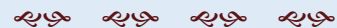

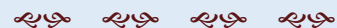


**Save the Dates!**

## PRINCE OF PEACE COUNCIL RETREAT

### History

*(Information from Lutheran Care website)*

- The original building at 255 East Main Street was erected in 1894 as a private residence of Samuel Leeds Allen, inventor of the Flexible Flyer sled. He called the Tudor gothic castle “Breidenhart,” meaning “broad hearth stone” or “hospitality.”
- In 1920, the Home was purchased by Eldridge R. Johnson, inventor of the Victor Talking Machine.
- In 1947, Johnson’s widow sold the house and its 12 landscaped acres to what was then the Lutheran Home of New Jersey.
- In 1961, the Home was renamed “Lutheran Home at Moorestown.”
- In 1978, the building of Pennsylvania limestone and Indiana sandstone trimmings was added to the National Register of Historic Places.
- In 2007, the name “Lutheran Care at Moorestown” was adopted to reflect the expanded comprehensive services being provided, including Sub-Acute Rehabilitation and Community Health Services to seniors, in addition to the long-term care that has become so well known.

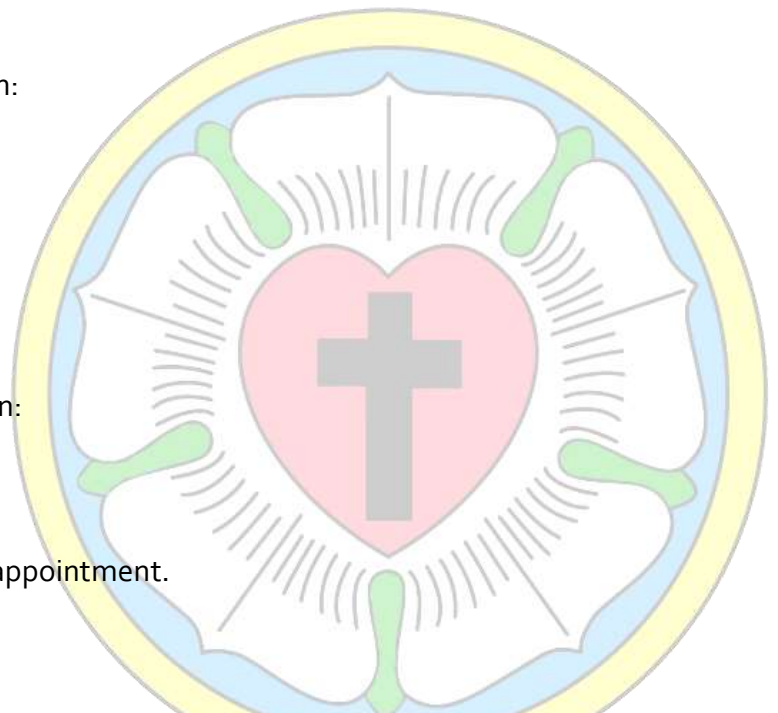
