### **Community-Based:**

Our goal is to keep the child in the community, in their home.

### **Family-Driven:**

The family knows the strengths and needs of the child best. *We are here to listen to what you need.*

### **Strengths-Based:**

We will focus on your strengths and how they can help you meet your goals.

### **Team-Based:**

Your Child-Family Team is made up of those people who are most important to your family. Together, the Team provides supports and services to help your child.

### **Individualized:**

Services will be tailored to suit your child and family's needs. The Child-Family Team creates a service plan that is truly responsive to your concerns.

### **Culturally Competent:**

Our culturally diverse staff is prepared to work with children and families from different experiences and backgrounds. *We value diversity in all of its expressions.*

### **Easily-Accessible:**

Partners for Kids and Families offers 24-hours on-call coverage to assist you in time of crisis.

## Care Management

Every child referred to Partners for Kids and Families will work with a Care Manager. The Care Manager's first job is to **listen to you**: to learn your concerns, to identify your needs and to acknowledge your strengths.

The Care Manager will work with you to build a *Child-Family Team*. This Team includes those people who know your child and family best. The Team is a balance of professionals (therapist, probation officer, and teacher) and informal supports (friends, relatives). Every voice on the Team is important.

The Child-Family Team develops an *Individual Service Plan* for the child. This plan is necessary to provide services for your child. It is strengths-based and tailored to your child's needs. It addresses all areas of your child's life, including: family interactions, safety, emotional supports, education, legal issues and medical concerns.

The Individual Service Plan changes as the strengths and needs of the child change. The goal is to develop a plan that is sustainable by the family. Services are paid for by a combination of funding: Medicaid, Private Insurance, Community Resources, and the Family.

## Enrollment in the Care Management Organization

The Care Management Organization works with children who have serious emotional and behavioral issues and their families.

The criteria used for determining enrollment in the CMO is as follows:

### Multiple-system involvement:

The child is involved in one or more of the following systems: Mental Health, Juvenile Justice, Child Welfare.

### At Risk of Out-of-Home Placement:

The child is in a Psychiatric Hospital, Residential Treatment Center, or Group Home, or is at risk of being placed in an out of home treatment program.

### Psychological Diagnosis:

The child has a diagnosis that indicates a serious emotional disorder.
