- Ministry Updates
 - o **Building Community** minutes attached
 - Addiction and Mental Health / Health Support Workshop long-term living (Wayne Grant) Replenishing first aid kits, purchasing 'fluid cleanup kits'. Trying to find a speaker for 'cutting' behavior.
 - <u>Family and Education</u> No meeting. Pastor Brett reported that both Discipleship Training (Sunday School) and Confirmation are on the smaller size, but lots of activity and flexible schedule going with the flow. Discipleship Training is exciting. Parent's continue to come with their children, working with the activities. Meeting schedules with individual families, trying to the families into worship.

MORTGAGE PAID OFF Now that we have paid off the mortgage we are able to save over thousands of dollars in interest which is a good thing but this does not mean that our expenses will be less. We need our giving income to continue so we may attend to some important endeavors. Over the next two years (the time remaining on the mortgage) the POP Council is suggesting that we spend what would have been spent on the mortgage \$40,000 a year on the following projects:

- 1/3 to savings (\$13,200)
- 1/3 to desperately needed capital improvements to the building (\$13,200)
- 1/3 to active ministry Which means: increase synod mission support by 1%, give significant Support to Bridge of Peace Lutheran Church in Camden, and to help move other ministry efforts here at POP forward. (\$13,200)
