## BEST DOG COOKIES EVER

2 cups whole wheat flour  
1 tablespoon baking powder

1 cup natural peanut butter  
1 cup skim milk

Preheat oven to 375°. Combine flour and baking powder in one bowl and peanut butter and milk in another. Add wet ingredients to dry ingredients and mix well. Roll dough out on a lightly floured surface and knead. Roll out to 1/4 inch thickness. Use cookie cutters to cut out shapes. Place on a greased cookie sheet and bake for 20 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool on a rack. Use snack-sized plastic storage bags. Place several treats in each for distribution at your Blessing Event. Store bags in a cool, dry place or refrigerate until needed.

## TUNA KITTY TREATS

3 oz. tuna in oil, undrained & shredded  
1/2 cup whole wheat flour  
1/2 cup dried milk

1 tablespoon vegetable oil  
1 large egg, beaten  
1/4 cup water

Preheat oven to 350°. Combine tuna, flour and dried milk. Blend in water and oil. In a small bowl, beat egg until it's frothy then stir into other ingredients. The mixture will be moist and sticky. Shape the mixture into marble-sized balls and place them on cookie sheets that have been sprayed with non-stick cooking spray. Lightly flatten each ball. Bake for approximately 10 minutes. Cool on cookie sheet for several minutes, then gently turn them over. Bake for an additional 10 minutes or until they are lightly browned. Cool on a wire rack. Once completely cool, place in an airtight container. Use snack-sized plastic storage bags. Place several treats in each for distribution at your Blessing Event. Store bags in a cool, dry place or refrigerate until needed.
