
Dear Members of Prince of Peace,

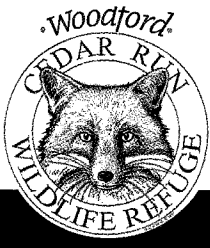

I am happy to report that we finally received approval to lease the convent on the OLPH campus in Maple Shade. The convent was formerly occupied by the Sisters of Saint Joseph. When we first started investigating the idea of using the convent for emergency shelter almost two years ago, the sisters were ecstatic that we would be using their former home to continue their mission of serving the poor. It has taken more time and energy than we had hoped to bring the idea to fruition, but we can now report that we should be ready to accept guest families soon.

I am so grateful for my work here at Family Promise, where I have the daily opportunity to live out my faith and my values by serving others.
